The selected service provider will be responsible for producing high-quality multimedia materials that effectively showcase the work and capabilities of the Rubber Research Institute of Sri Lanka (RRISL).

- Provide **high-quality professional photographs** featuring:

4. Eligibility Criteria

Interested bidders must:

- Be a legally registered company in Sri Lanka.
- Have a minimum of 3 years of experience in professional video production. (Proof documents should be attached)
- Have successfully completed at least 3 similar projects with government organizations or/and reputed private companies.
- Possess all necessary equipment and personnel for video production.
