It is mandatory for bidders to visit the site and inspect the existing IP-based surveillance system and Fiber Optic VLAN at Dartonfield, Agalawatte, before submitting their bids.

Bids will be closed at 2.00 pm on 23.09.2026 and they will be opened immediately after the closing time on the same day at Dartonfield, Agalawatte. The decision of the Procurement Committee will be final and definite. Bidders or their authorized representatives will be permitted to be present at the time of opening of bids.

A: General	
1. Scope of Bid	1.1 The Purchaser named in the Data Sheet invites you to submit a quotation for the supply of Goods as specified in Section III Schedule of Requirements. Upon receipt of this invitation, you are requested to acknowledge the receipt of this invitation and your intention to submit a quotation. The Purchaser may not consider you for inviting quotations in the future, if you failed to acknowledge the receipt of this invitation or not submitting a quotation after expressing the intention as above.

C: Preparation of Quotation	
3. Documents Comprising your Quotation	3.1 The Quotation shall comprise the following: (a) Quotation Submission Form and the Price Schedules; (b) Technical Specifications & Compliance with Specifications
4. Quotation Submission Form and Price Schedules	4.1 The vendor shall submit the Quotation Submission Form using the form furnished in Section V. This form must be completed without any alterations to its format, and no substitutes shall be accepted. All blank spaces shall be filled in with the information requested. 4.2 Alternative offers shall not be considered. The vendors are advised not to quote different options for the same item but furnish the most competitive among the options available to the bidder.
5. Prices and Discounts	5.1 Unless specifically stated in Data Sheet, all items must be priced separately in the Price Schedules. 5.2 The price to be quoted in the Quotation Submission Form shall be the total price of the Quotation, including any discounts offered.

	5.3 The applicable VAT shall be indicated separately. 5.4 Prices quoted by the vendor shall be fixed during the vendor's performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account. A Quotation submitted with an adjustable price shall be treated as non-responsive and may be rejected.
6. Currency	6.1 The vendors shall quote only in Sri Lanka Rupees.
7. Documents to Establish the Conformity of the Goods	7.1 The vendor shall furnish as part of its quotation the documentary evidence that the Goods conform to the technical specifications and standards specified in Section IV, "Technical Specifications & Compliance with Specifications". 7.2 The documentary evidence may be in the form of literature, drawings or data, and shall consist of a detailed item by item description of the essential technical and performance characteristics of the Goods, demonstrating substantial responsiveness of the Goods to the technical specifications, and if applicable, a statement of deviations and exceptions to the provisions of the Technical Specifications given. 7.3 If stated in the Data Sheet the vendor shall submit a certificate from the manufacturer to demonstrate that it has been duly authorized by the manufacturer or producer of the Goods to supply these Goods in Sri Lanka.
8. Period of Validity of quotation	8.1 Quotations shall remain valid for the period of sixty (60) days after the quotation submission deadline date.
9. Format and Signing of Quotation	9.1 The quotation shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the vendor.
D: Submission and Opening of Quotation	
10. Submission of Quotation	10.1 Vendors may submit their quotations by registered post, courier service or by hand in sealed envelopes addressed to the Purchaser bear the specific identification of the contract number. 10.2 If the quotation is not sealed and marked as required, the Purchaser will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the quotation.
11. Deadline for Submission of Quotation	11.1 Quotation must be received by the Purchaser at the address set out in Section II, "Data Sheet", and no later than the date and time as specified in the Data Sheet.
12. Late Quotations	12.1 The Purchaser shall reject any quotation that arrives after the deadline for submission of quotations, in accordance with ITV Clause 11.1 above.

13. Opening of Quotations	13.1 The Purchaser shall conduct the opening of quotation in public at the address, date and time specified in the Data Sheet. 13.2 A representative of the bidders may be present and mark its attendance.
E: Evaluation and Comparison of Quotation	
14. Clarifications	14.1 To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of the quotations, the Purchaser may, at its discretion, ask any vendor for a clarification of its quotation. Any clarification submitted by a vendor in respect to its quotation which is not in response to a request by the Purchaser shall not be considered. 14.2 The Purchaser's request for clarification and the response shall be in writing.
15. Responsiveness of Quotations	15.1 The Purchaser will determine the responsiveness of the quotation to the documents based on the contents of the quotation received. 15.2 If a quotation is evaluated as not substantially responsive to the documents issued, it may be rejected by the Purchaser.
16. Evaluation of quotation	16.1 The Purchaser shall evaluate each quotation that has been determined, to be substantially responsive. 16.2 To evaluate a quotation, the Purchaser may consider the following: (a) the Price as quoted; (b) price adjustment for correction of arithmetical errors; (c) price adjustment due to discounts offered. 16.3 The Purchaser's evaluation of a quotation may require the consideration of other factors, in addition to the Price quoted if stated in Section II, Data Sheet. Eligibility, Technical, and Service Conditions

1. Scope of Work

The bidder shall:

- Supply the specified Wireless Bridge and accessories.
- Supply and install compatible surveillance-grade IP Based CCTV cameras suitable for continuous security monitoring applications.
- Install, configure, test, and commission the Wireless Bridge and CCTV cameras with the existing CCTV surveillance system.
- Integrate all existing IP CCTV cameras with the three (03) newly supplied IP CCTV cameras and configure the complete CCTV system to operate seamlessly with the existing network infrastructure, without interruption to ongoing operations.
- Install, configure, test, and commission the Mini PC and LED TV at the Main Security Hut. The Mini PC and LED TV will be provided by RRISL. The bidder shall provide all necessary brackets, mounting hardware, cables, connectors, and other accessories required for complete installation and commissioning.
- Configure recording schedules, user accounts, remote viewing, backup, and security settings.
- Provide training for client representatives.
- Provide warranty, preventive maintenance, and technical support services.

2. Eligibility Criteria for Bidders

Bidders shall:

- Be a legally registered company/business.
- Have minimum three (03) years of experience in Supply, Installation, Service, and Maintenance of IP based CCTV surveillance systems with networking infrastructure.
- Possess authorization or dealership for CCTV/security products (preferred).

3. Technical Requirements

- The proposed Wireless Bridge shall be compatible with the existing Fiber Optic VLAN.
- The proposed IP based CCTV cameras shall be compatible with the existing IP CCTV/security camera surveillance system.
- The bidder shall verify compatibility with the existing systems before submission.

4. Installation & Configuration Requirements

The successful bidder shall:

- Install the Wireless Bridge at the designated locations (AP Site and CPE Site).
- Configure the Wireless Bridge for the existing Fiber Optic VLAN.
- Install and configure the Mini PC and LED TV at Main Security Hut.
- Integrate all existing IP CCTV cameras and newly supplied IP CCTV cameras into the existing CCTV system and network infrastructure without interruption to ongoing operations.
- Ensure proper cable management and labeling.
- Conduct full system testing and commissioning.

5. Replacement of IP Based CCTV Camera

- The bidder shall supply and install three (03) Nos. of surveillance-grade, compatible IP-based CCTV cameras suitable for continuous security monitoring applications at locations designated by the institute (RRISL).
